ATTENDANCE

Dr. Carmine noted attendance reports for December:

- 21st Century – 91.65%, Algonquin – 85.40%, Barack Obama – 90.04%, Blackhawk – 90.95%, Michelle Obama – 90.85% and **Mohawk – 91.98%**

ACTION

In action taken, the Board approved:

- adoption of the supplemental tax levy resolution to pay the principal and interest on outstanding limited bonds of the District
- the BMO Bank bills with the exception of: bill 9 charge B, bill 9 charge C and bill 9 charge D
- participation in the Rich Township School District 227 enrollment study at a cost of \$2,560.00
- the extended personal illness leave for twenty-four days for a pretenured certified staff member due to extenuating circumstances
- the Consultant Agreement for retired teacher Mary Carroll, math intervention teacher
- the contractual agreement appointing Dr. Karen Burns as the assistant principal at Michelle Obama School effective January 22, 2018, through July 31, 2018
- a stipend for a staff member
- the contractual agreement between the Board of Education and Dr. Joyce Carmine as the interim superintendent effective July 1, 2018, for 100 days during the 2018-2019 school year, and as administrative consultant during the 2019-2020 school year, for 100 days
